These are our standard procedures:

1. Appointment to measure prospective Kitchen, Bathroom and/or Renovation Projects.
2. Visit to Client's home
 - a. Actual Measurement
 - b. Brief consultation of:
 - 1) Client's desires and needs
 - 2) Discussion of operation procedures and associated fees/cost.
3. Design Session
 - a. Present scaled plan of existing room
 - b. Discuss layout options
 - c. Agree on general layout
 - d. General discussion on client's material preferences (finishes, counters, etc.)
 - e. At this time we estimate a rough budget.
 - f. If you are comfortable in this budget, we proceed, if not, we will redesign to fit budget
4. Design and Pricing Complete
 - a. Review final plans and elevations
 - b. Review material and installation quotes
 - c. Review contract and payment schedule
 - d. Sign contract with 50% deposit

5. Contract Signed

- a. Will contact Client to confirm date of installation
- b. Will review with Client order of events and estimated completion date
- c. Payment schedule will be set up upon completion of specific stages during installation.
- d. Permits are the sole responsibility of the homeowner

6. Installation

7. Change Orders

1. Must be brought to installers' attention ASAP by Client
2. A written change order must be signed and paid in full before change is executed.

8. Final Payment

1. Final payment will be due upon final inspection. Final payment may not be withheld over anything covered under warranty.

Drawings Only

1. We will supply Client with full set of working drawings for a set fee, predetermined, according to job size.
2. Any changes to completed set; a \$250 charge per wall will be due prior to changes made.
